ESTABLISHED OVER 40 YEARS AGO IN SOUTH DERBYSHIRE, COLOMBIER VINS FINS HAVE GROWN INTO ONE OF THE UK'S MOST RESPECTED INDEPENDENT WINE MERCHANTS. THEY IMPORT DIRECTLY FROM BOUTIQUE GROWERS ACROSS THE GLOBE, WITH A PORTFOLIO OF MORE THAN 1,000 WINES SPANNING CLASSIC EUROPEAN VINEYARDS AND EXCITING NEW WORLD PRODUCERS.

COLOMBIER ARE KNOWN FOR THEIR PERSONAL APPROACH. THEY INVEST TIME IN BUILDING CLOSE RELATIONSHIPS WITH GROWERS, WHICH ALLOWS THEM TO OFFER WINES OF GENUINE PROVENANCE AND INDIVIDUALITY. THEIR PASSION LIES IN BRINGING BOTH TIMELESS FAVOURITES AND LESSER-KNOWN TREASURES TO UK ESTABLISHMENTS. ALWAYS WITH A FOCUS ON OUALITY AND CHARACTER.

OUR APPROACH TO WINE

AT WILDES, WINE IS MORE THAN A DRINK, IT'S AN EXPERIENCE. EACH BOTTLE ON OUR LIST HAS BEEN CHOSEN NOT JUST FOR ITS QUALITY, BUT FOR THE STORY IT TELLS OF THE PEOPLE AND PLACES BEHIND IT.

WE BELIEVE A GREAT WINE LIST SHOULD BALANCE THE FAMILIAR WITH THE UNEXPECTED: BOTTLES THAT FEEL LIKE OLD FRIENDS, ALONGSIDE DISCOVERIES WAITING TO BE SHARED. AT WILDES, WE WANT TO ELEVATE THE CLASSIC FAVOURITES YOU ALREADY LOVE WHILE ALSO ENCOURAGING YOU TO BRANCH OUT AND EXPLORE SOMETHING NEW. WHETHER IT'S A DIFFERENT GRAPE VARIETY, A LESSER-KNOWN REGION, OR A BOLD STYLE YOU'VE NOT TRIED BEFORE, OUR LIST IS DESIGNED TO INVITE CURIOSITY AS WELL AS COMFORT. THAT'S WHY WE WORK CLOSELY WITH INDEPENDENT MERCHANTS WHO KNOW THEIR GROWERS PERSONALLY, ALLOWING US TO BRING AUTHENTIC AND CHARACTERFUL WINES TO YOUR TABLE.

OUR AIM IS SIMPLE: TO CREATE MOMENTS WORTH SAVOURING. WHETHER IT'S A CRISP GLASS IN THE SUN, A BOLD RED OVER DINNER, OR A BOTTLE SHARED LATE INTO THE EVENING, WINE AT WILDES IS ALWAYS ABOUT CONNECTION, CONVERSATION, AND ENJOYMENT.

Pol Roger Reserve

125ML - £15 Bottle - £80 The Brut Réserve is a blend in equal parts of the three champenois grape varieties: pinot noir, pinot meunier and chardonnay from 30 different crus. 25% reserve wines are used to produce this cuyée Pol Roger Blanc De Blanc Bottle - £120 The 2015 Brut Blanc de Blancs is exclusively made from Chardonnays selected from the Grands Crus of the Côte des Blancs: Oiry, Chouilly, Cramant, Avize, Oger and Le Mesnilsur-Oger. Produced in limited quantities, this Cuvée has been aged for 6 years in our cellars before being released onto the market.

Pol Roger Vintage Bottle - £120 The 2018 Brut Vintage from Champagne Pol Roger is made from the traditional house vintage blend of 60% Pinot Noir and 40% Chardonnay from 20 Grands and Premiers crus vineyards in the Montagne de Reims and the Côte des Blancs.

Pol Roger Demi-Sec Bottle - £80 Cuvée Rich (launched in 2001) is a beautifully balanced demi-sec champagne, crafted for those with a refined sweet tooth. Aged for 4 years and finished with a 34g/l dosage, it blends Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier, and Chardonnay from 30 crus, offering a luscious, fresh, and elegant finish.

Pol Roger Vintage Rose

Bottle - £130

The Brut Rosé Vintage 2018 is a refined blend of 50% Pinot Noir and 35% Chardonnay, sourced from over 20 Premiers and Grands Crus across the Montagne de Reims and Côte des Blancs.

Pol Roger Sir Winston Churchill Bottle - £250 Cuvée Sir Winston Churchill is Pol Roger's tribute to the legendary statesman — bold, mature, and refined.

Made from Grands Crus Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, it's crafted only in the finest vintages and released late to reflect Churchill's love for aged champagne.

Pol Roger Pure Extra Brut Bottle - £90

Brought out in 2008, this cuvée is a true expression of the Pol Roger house style — crafted to showcase champagne in its most natural form. Undosed and perfectly balanced, it blends the three grape varieties in equal measure, preserving the authentic character and diversity of the terroirs.
